A LETTER FROM PASTOR TROY

As a musician who is only average at best, I stand in awe when I am in the presence of a truly great musician. Particularly when that musician is playing one of the instruments I attempt to play. When I see an amazing drummer, or a guitar virtuoso, or a master pianist - because I happen to play those particular musical instruments - I listen intently. But I also watch. I watch what they do and how they do it. Why? Because I hope to learn some new trick, some technique, some riff, some new chops that I can incorporate into my playing. And if the opportunity affords itself, I have no hesitation in going up to that musician and asking him or her to teach me how they did what they did.

There was a point during the early ministry of Jesus when His disciples had the opportunity to do the same thing. They had the opportunity to ask the Master Teacher to teach them something. I can think of many things they could have asked Him to teach them. The disciples might have gone to Him and said, "Jesus, teach us how to turn water into wine." Or "Teach us how to walk on water." Or they even could have said, "Teach us how to raise people from the dead." But the New Testament tells us of a different request the disciples brought to Jesus. They came to Him on one occasion, as Luke records in his gospel, they asked this: "*Lord, teach us to pray*" (Luke 11:1). I find it fascinating that this was the burning question they brought to Jesus. They wanted to gain a special insight into prayer as a skill or an art.

Why did they ask Him this question? My guess is they saw the connection between Jesus' extraordinary prayer life and His power, His teaching, His character, His whole person. They must have noticed that after ministering to large crowds of people, Jesus often would withdraw by Himself. He must have felt drained from that ministry. During such times, Jesus would not simply withdraw for a half hour or so. Rather, He would go apart for long periods, and when He did so, He usually spent much of the time in intense seasons of prayer. Why? Because *Prayer Matters*.

Beginning June 11, we will embark on a five-week journey with Jesus Christ in the school of prayer. We will consider the example of how he prayed and his instructions on how we should pray. I believe with all my heart, as we become a more intentionally prayerful people, we will know God's presence and experience God's power in remarkable ways.

PRAY:



- Pray for the staff, teachers, and volunteers as they lead the children in their exploration of the God of the universe, teaching them about His desire for a personal relationship with each of one them.

Romans 8:39


