A LETTER FROM PASTOR TROY

A CHURCH-WIDE TRIP TO THE MOVIES!

In June of this year, you sent me, Amy, Amber, and Trevor to the Southern Baptist Convention in Nashville as your messengers. We joined 15,000 other messengers from across the country for four days of meetings, gatherings, equipping, and inspiration. There are always dozens of extra activities and sponsored events surrounding those four days of meetings. One such event was Lifeway Films, along with The Kendrick Brothers, premiering a FULL screening of their brand new film, *Show Me The Father*. The Kendrick Brothers have produced other films you're likely familiar with: *Facing The Giants, Courageous, Overcomer,* and others.

Show Me The Father is different from all their other films in that it's not a fictional drama with actors, but a real-life documentary with actual people telling their stories. The film follows several true fatherhood stories – some positive, some negative – while intertwining Biblical principles about the Fatherhood of God throughout the film. It is incredibly well done.

In the providence of God, we attended the screening. Let me tell you, I was not prepared for how profoundly I would be impacted by the film. As I began to reflect that evening on my own responsibility as a father to the children God's entrusted to me, my mind went to all the fathers I have the privilege of serving as pastor. I determined right then and there – I want EVERY father in our church to see this film. Since then, I have been praying that it will be a tool God uses, to launch a vibrant, ongoing men's ministry. In fact, I was so moved by the film, I wanted pastors in our city to see it too! So in association with the film's distributer, I hosted a free screening for 65 pastors and leaders this past week (including our staff & elders). This was my second time seeing the film and it hit me as hard as the first time seeing it!

Show Me The Father is set to release on the weekend of September 10. Though theater schedules have not been released, our plan is to purchase group tickets for the afternoon of Saturday, September 11. I've already checked ALL the relevant SEC football schedules and guess what – no SEC teams are playing conference games that afternoon. And we don't want just our men to see it; we encourage all of our families to see it together. My desire is to be able to rent out an entire theater! Ticket prices for you will only be \$3 per person. In addition to the film that weekend, I have changed my preaching schedule and will be extending our "Summer of Hope" series by one week. My sermon for that morning will be, "The Hope of a Father." Please join me in praying for God to do great things in the lives of our men, and by extension the lives of our marriages and families.




INTERNATIONAL MISSION BOARD




HELP FEED LYHS FOOTBALL
