A LETTER FROM PASTOR TROY

Strange New World

If you've ever had the occasion to plunge into the depths of Lookout Mountain to see our famous local attraction, Ruby Falls, you were no doubt led on that excursion by a tour guide. This guide likely discussed how they believe the falls were formed, when and how they were discovered, and who the "Ruby" is for whom they were named. Having a knowledgeable tour guide gives insight and understanding to all you are seeing and experiencing.

Dr. Carl Trueman is something of a tour guide as well. Not for natural phenomena occurring in the geological world, but for unnatural and strange phenomena occurring in the social world. In his new book, *Strange New World*, he maneuvers through the cultural and philosophical theories of the last 200 years which have influenced much of what we see happening in modern society. 

YOUTH CAMP JUNE 13-16 @ SHOCCO SPRINGS



The name of our senior adult group is *Wise & Wonderful*, and that is more than a title, it's a living reality. We welcome everyone to our meetings each month, especially OLD PEOPLE of 55. If you don't think you're old at 55, ask a 20 year old! LOL

Our program generally has a guest speaker with a testimony or biblical message of 15-20 minutes. We are currently aligning more significant people as our guest speakers each month and you'll be blessed to hear their hearts. What we're seeking to do is spiritually fellowship with our church family by getting to know each others heart.
